

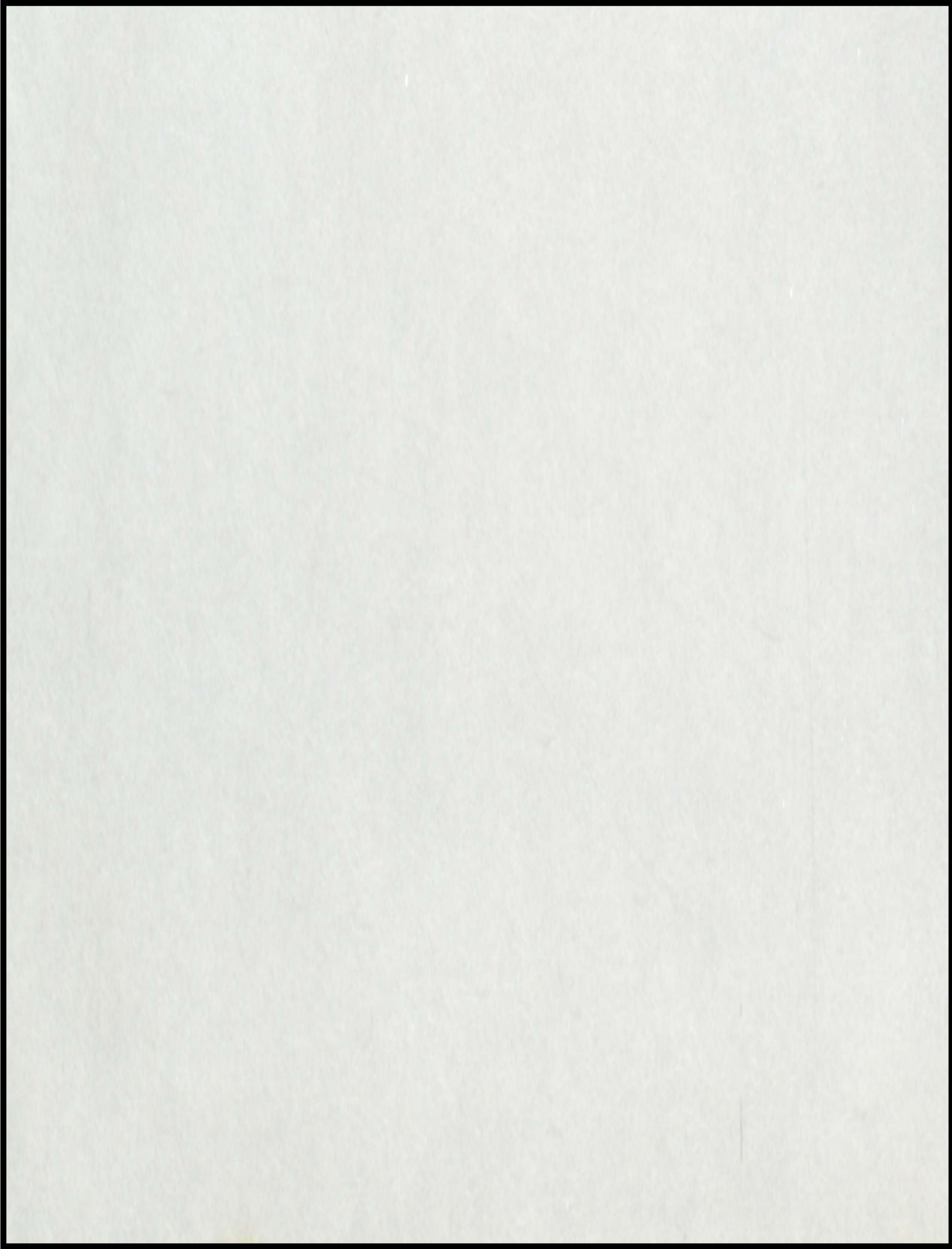

recognize these moments and do your best to make note of them. All too often we get so concerned about where we want to go, that we forget to enjoy the trip.

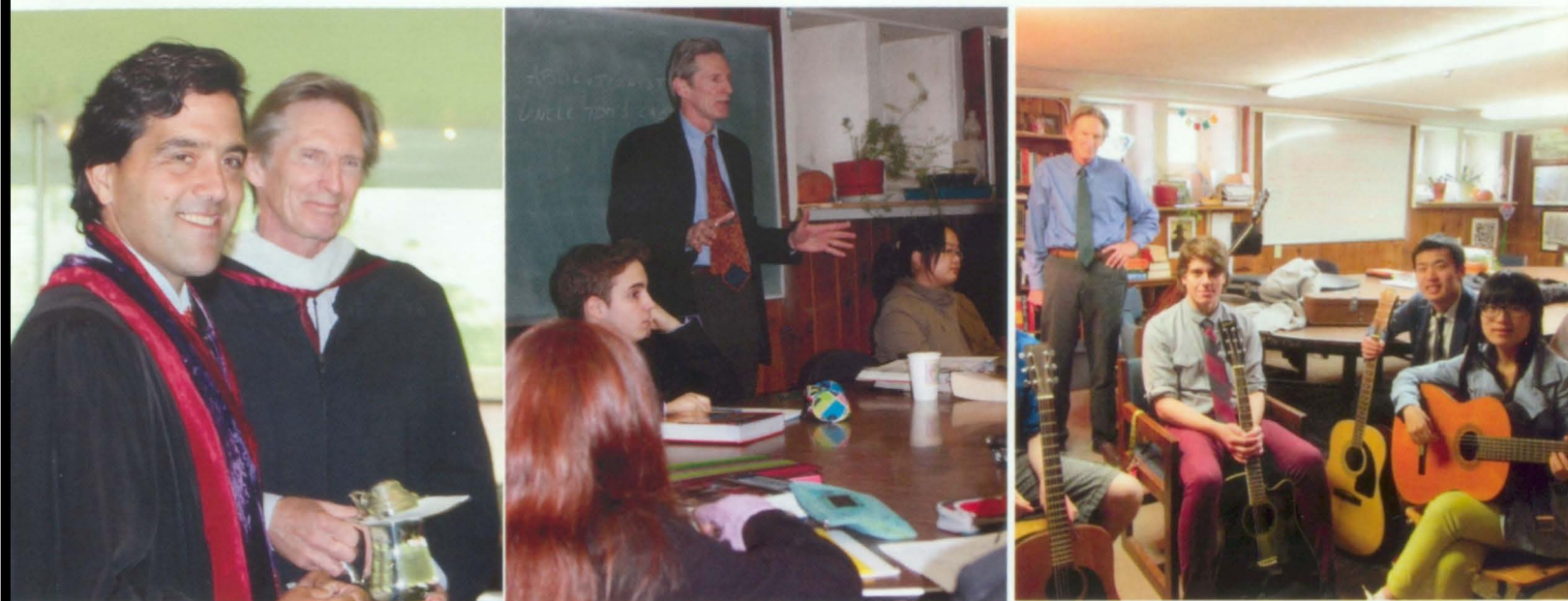

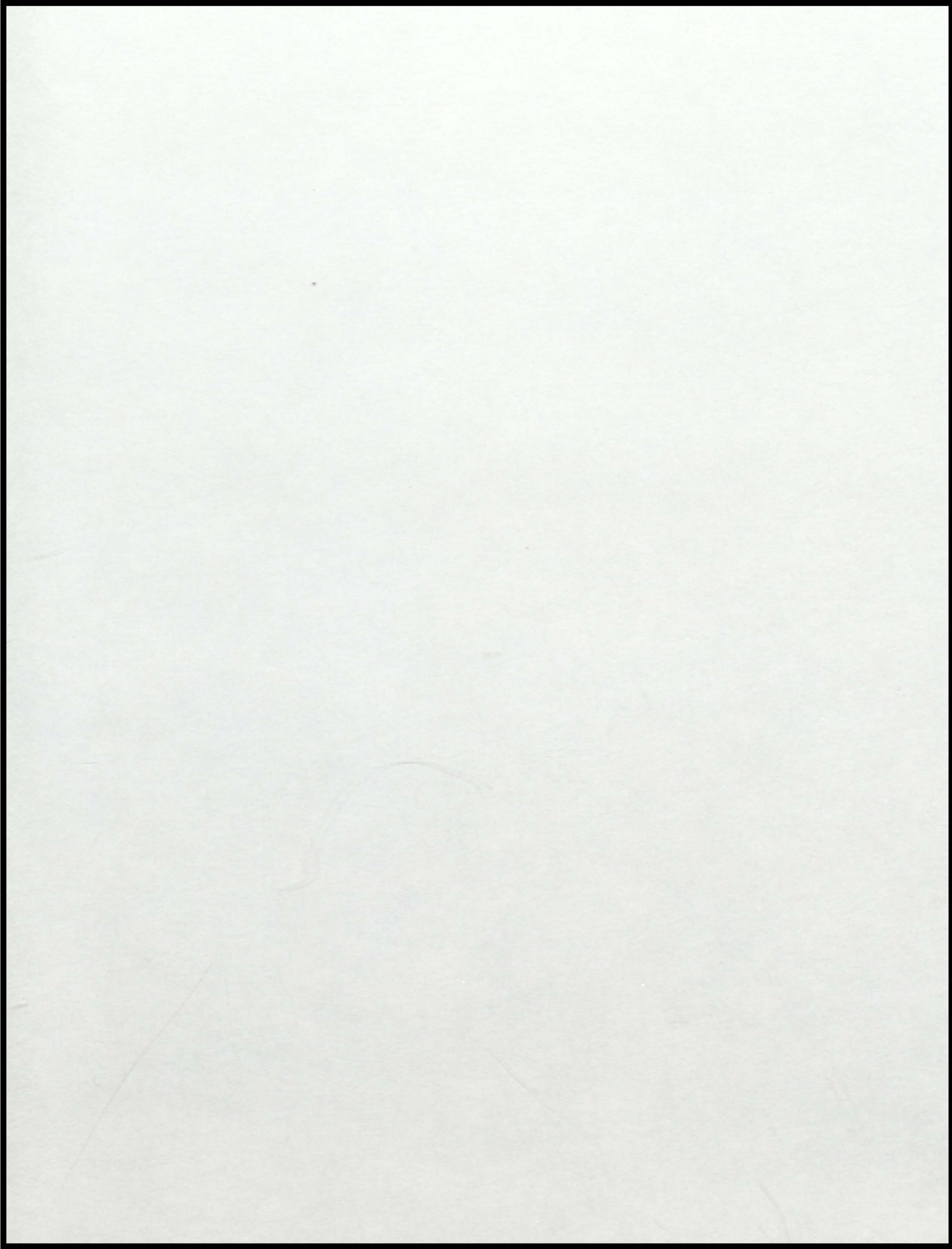
In loving memory of *Donn Wright*
