The Bleeze Banquet marks a beginning and an end.



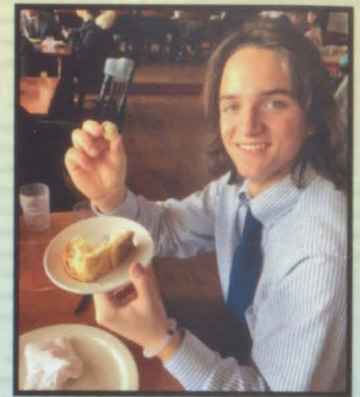
Beginning with the traditional burning of the Yule Log greens, Seniors gather around a bonfire to begin their journey to graduation together.
