The fire symbolizes the End of the Jester's reign by symbolically "sweeping him up the chimney with smoke."





IN LOVING MEMORY OF H. ASHTON CROSBY, JR. 1940 - 2015



H. Ashton Crosby is remembered in the Hoosac's 2016 Owl for his dedication and loyalty to the Hoosac Community. No matter his position, either as the Director of Admission, Headmaster, a teacher, a theatrical director, or a mentor, Mr. Crosby always had a positive influence upon those he connected with. He was an easygoing man; a quality that made him one of the best headmasters in students' opinion. Mr. Crosby was approachable, caring, and eccentric in all of the right ways. He encouraged students to become engaged in the theater, and those who listened, were transformed into young men and women through his gentle guidance and enthusiasm.

Mr. Henry Perez is one of those men who felt Mr. Crosby helped shape him as a person. He described Ashton as a father figure to him, who taught him the basics of being a man. Some of those credentials included tying a tie, owning a suit, and of course, advice on the ladies.

Mr. Richard Lomuscio wrote, "His (Mr. Crosby's) intelligence, wit, good humor, and charisma left indelible marks on generations of students. He found the best in all of them."
